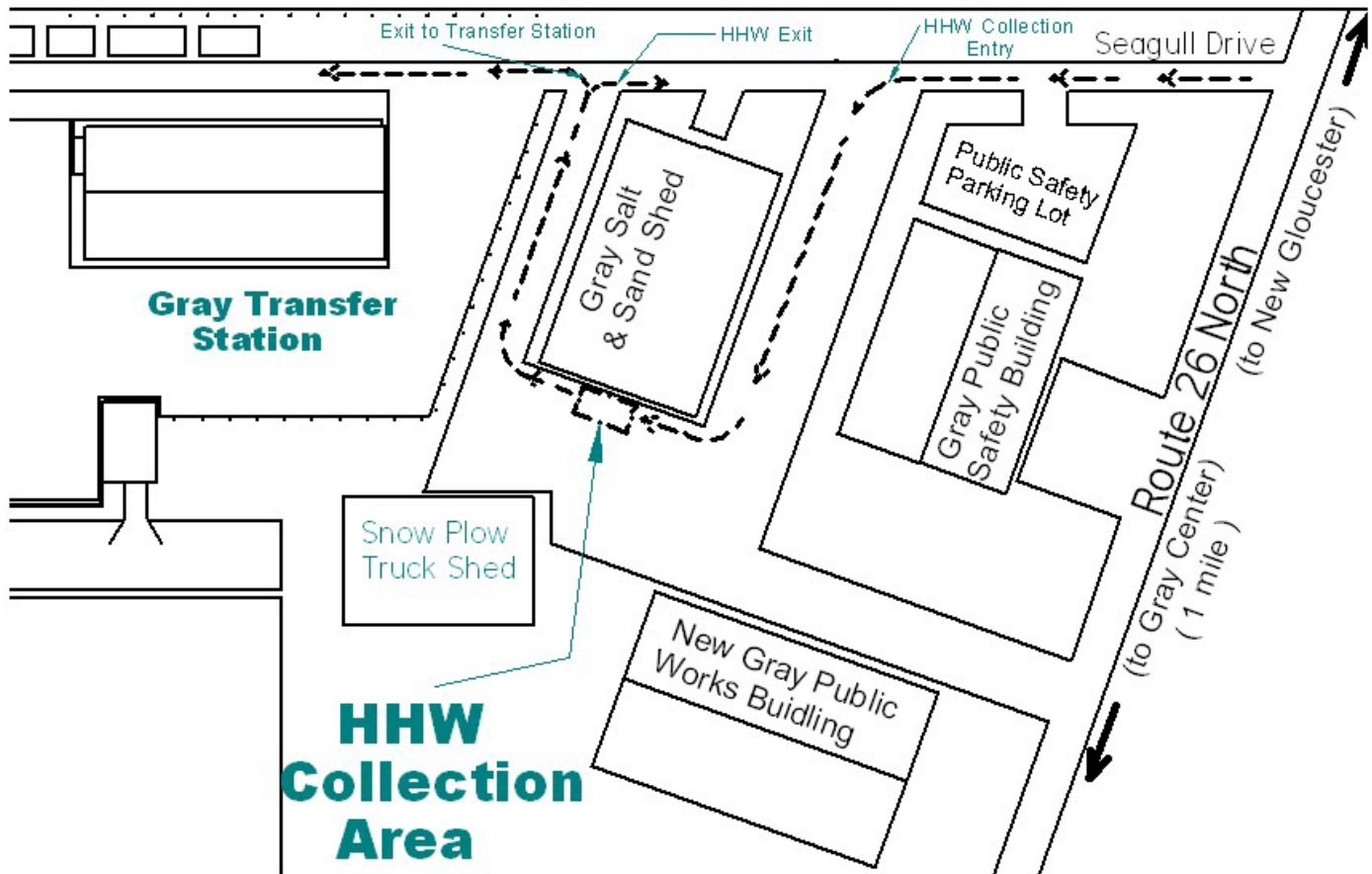

Household Hazardous Waste

What items are accepted?

****Residential waste only****

Household items include:

Abrasive Cleaners, Ammonia Based Cleaners, Bleach Cleaners, Degreasers, Disinfectants, Floor Cleaner and Wax, Furniture Polish, Moth Balls, Oven Cleaners, Pool Chemicals, Rug and Upholstery Cleaners, Rust and Spot Removers, Silver Cleaners, Toilet and Drain Cleaners. Acids and Corrosive Material. Muriatic Acid.

Garden Products include:

Fertilizers, Fungicides, Herbicides, Insecticides, Pesticides, Roach and Ant Killers, Rodent Poison, Soil Fumigants, Weed Killers, Acids and Corrosives.

Auto Products include:

Antifreeze*, Auto Body Filler, Brake Fluid, Car Cleaners, Car Waxes and Chrome Polish, Carburetor Cleaner, Engine Degreaser, Gasoline, Used or Unused Motor Oil (including diesel fuel, kerosene, lamp oil and transmission fluid)*, Acids and Corrosives.

*= Bring these items only if your local transfer station does not accept them.

Paint, Hobby and Pet Products include:

Caulks Glues and Cements, Chemistry Sets, Flea Powder and Collars, Flea Spray and Shampoo, Lacquers & Stains, Oil Based Paints (**NO LATEX**), Mineral Spirits, Model Airplane Paints, Paint Remover and Stripper, Paint Thinners and Turpentine, Photographic Chemicals and Solutions, Resins, Fiberglass and Epoxy, Varnishes, Wood Preservatives, Acids and Corrosives.

If you have questions about an item please call your local transfer station.

What items are not accepted?

****No commercial waste****

Latex Paints* (mix w/ shavings or cat litter and add to trash) / Fire Extinguishers, Propane Tanks, Computer Monitors, Televisions (accepted at transfer station) / Biological or Medical Wastes (contact a local hospital for instructions) / Ammunition, Explosive or Fireworks (contact State Police) / Radioactive Material (not accepted)

How do I transport hazardous waste?

Do not transport more than 15 gallons or 100lbs.

Use containers less than or equal to 5 gallons.

Do not mix wastes together.

Use robust sealed containers.

Use original container when possible, cover old labels and clearly mark if using new containers.

Place containers in a cardboard box. Glass containers should be wrapped in cloth or newspaper.

Place wastes in trunk or bed of truck, keep away from passengers.

Provide ventilation by opening a window.

Follow directions once you reach the collection site.

At the site the staff will unload your vehicle. You will be asked to stay inside your vehicle.
