The Maine Department of Transportation is currently working on estimating a highway safety project just North of Foster Hill Road to South of Intervale & Bald Hill Road for advertisement of the subject project for competitive bids in January 2017. Construction will occur during the summer months, exact start and completion dates will be forwarded once a schedule from the Contractor has been reviewed and approved.

The project is further described as follows:

CENTERLINE RUMBLE STRIP INSTALLATION at the 45 mph sign North of Foster Hill Road to 40 mph sign South of Intervale & Bald Hill Road. Centerline rumble strips will be installed in areas that speeds are 45 MPH or over, shoulder widths that meet or exceed 4' in width and will allow for breaks at side roads and entrances.
