It is the respondent's responsibility to ensure that submissions are received prior to 12:00 PM on Thursday November 2nd. Submissions received after the specified closing date and/or time will not be considered. The Town shall not be responsible for the proper identification and handling of any qualifications submitted.

Method of Award

The Town of Gray reserves the right to select the bid "most advantageous to the Town" meaning a bid chosen basis of price, quality of merchandise, suitability of merchandise, and service reputation of the vendor, and not necessarily for the lowest bid received. The bids shall be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Price
- Delivery Date

The Town's selection will be made by the Gray Town Council based on a recommendation from the Director of Buildings and Grounds. It is anticipated that the council will award the bid at the November 14th Town Council Meeting.

Failure to acknowledge receipt of amendments, in accordance with the instructions contained in the amendments, may result in a firm's response not being considered.
