

PROPOSED TOWN CHARTER AMENDMENTS  
TO CONFORM TO STATE ELECTION LAWS

Shall Art. II and Art. IV of the Gray Town Charter be amended as follows:

Article II. Town Council

Section 3. Nominations.

Nomination papers for the nomination of candidates for any elective office in the Town of Gray shall be filed with the Town Clerk at least ~~forty five (45)~~ sixty (60) days prior to the regular municipal election. Nomination papers shall be uniform and shall be made available by the Town Clerk ~~ninety (90)~~ one hundred five (105) days prior to the election.

Article IV. School Administrative District

Section 3. Nominations.

Nomination papers for candidates for any elective office in the Town of Gray shall be filed with the Town Clerk at least ~~forty five (45)~~ sixty (60) days prior to the regular municipal election. Nomination papers shall be uniform and shall be made available by the Town Clerk ~~ninety (90)~~ one hundred five (105) days prior to the election.

[Explanation: The purpose of these proposed amendments is to bring the election provisions of the Town Charter into conformity with recent changes in the governing State election laws. These charter amendments shall take effect at the beginning of the next calendar year, January 1, 2018.]
